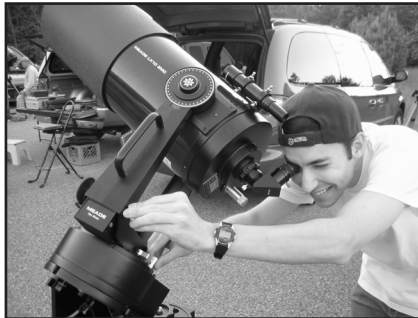
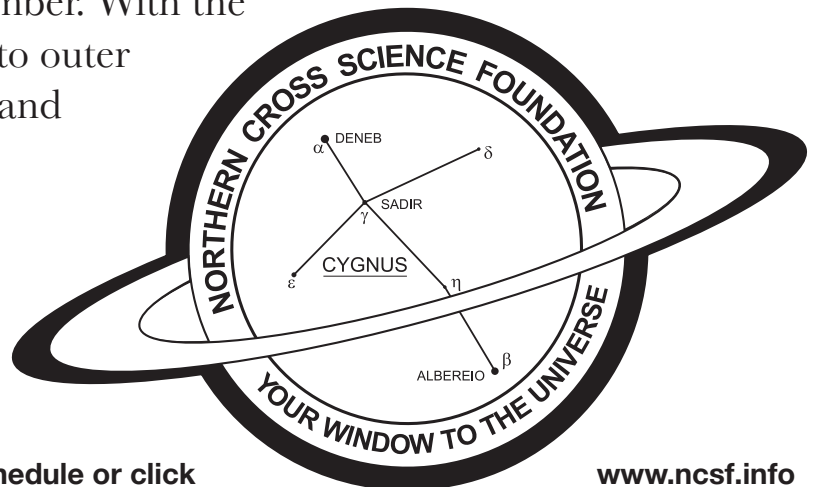


Your Window to the Universe!
